

# “Zap the Flu at North Ranch”

Mollen Immunization Clinics developed a comprehensive school influenza immunization program called “Zap the Flu at School.” This school-based immunization program has been designed to assist schools and communities in implementing the recommendations of both the Advisory Committees on Immunization Practices (ACIP) and the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) for influenza vaccination in school districts across the country. Mollen Immunization Clinics contracts directly with most insurance companies and has joined with government agencies to provide immunizations to children.

North Ranch will have a student immunization clinic for the seasonal and the Novel H1N1 virus on Friday, November 6, 2009. This clinic will take place during the regular school day. If you wish for your child to participate, registration will be completed online. Students nine years of age and younger will require a second dose of the H1N1 vaccine. Parents of students requiring a second dose will be notified when the second clinic date is determined.
