Transportation, Pick-up and Drop-off:

- District Transportation Department provides information on bus schedules and stops: (602) 449-2251. It can also be accessed through the P.V.U.S.D. website.
- Parent Drop-off: Students may be dropped off after 8:40 AM. K-2 students enter on south side, 3-6 enter on north side
- Parent Pick-up: East parking lot is closed at dismissal. Follow all traffic laws and do not ask your child to cross streets to get to your car. West lot pick-ups require parents to park and exit car.
- Crossing Guards help children cross at 68th & Thunderbird and 68th & Hearn. Students arriving early will be asked to wait with crossing guards.
